Part B: Safety Assessment of Cosmetic Product

The cosmetic product

Altruist Sunscreen SPF50

can be assessed as

SAFE

for normal and reasonably foreseeable use in accordance with the European Cosmetics Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009.

The safety evaluation of the cosmetic product is based on the chemical composition of the formula (as found in the manufacturing formulation and INCI composition considering the inspection requirements of the raw materials and finished goods), on the toxicological profile of each ingredient, available toxicological and dermatological data of the raw materials and the finished product, including microbiological tests, safety data sheets, legal regulations, generally binding international assessments (*e.g.* by the Cosmetic Ingredient Review (CIR), recommendations of authorities and associations, as well as the conditions of use as intended and unintended use as foreseeable within reason.

The grade of exposition results from the conditions of use regarding the COLIPA guidelines as well as the directions for use on the product packaging. The voluntary and legally prescribed warnings as well as other consumer information are referred for safety measures, as far they are part of the product packaging.

Responsibility for the observations on reclamations and possible misuse, as well as the resulting evaluations, lies with distributor.

Compliance with the „Good Manufacturing Practice“ takes place in accordance with the Cosmetics GMP (DIN EN ISO 22716). The safety evaluation of the cosmetic product according to Cosmetics GMP is not considered.
